

Kindergarten Supply List

See your teacher's door for amendments to the list and wish items. It is not necessary to buy every item on the list. Every child does need to have a change of socks and clothes in a labeled gallon Ziploc bag. We are outside every day, even on very rainy days; we get wet! Raincoats and rain boots can be worn from home, or live under their hook for fast changes.

To share with the class:

- 1 package of glue sticks
- 1 box of crackers or other healthy snack every month (no nuts, please)
- 1 package of Dixon Ticonderoga pencils (they last and the erasers work)
- 1 ream of recycled copy paper
- 1 ream of colored copy paper
- 1 tablet of watercolor paper
- 1 box Crayola markers (not skinny)
- 24 pack of crayola crayons
- Last names A-L: 1 box of Kleenex, 1 package of baby wipes, 1 package black fine point sharpies (not extra fine)
- Last names M-Z: pump hand soap or environmental cleaning product for table cleaning, 1 roll of masking tape

To keep by your hook in our classroom:

- Rain boots
- Raincoat
- Change of clothes
- 2 pairs of socks

Also you need:

- Backpack
- Reusable lunch supplies (for full day)
- Rain pants (nice to have, but not necessary)
- A family picture in a frame

We really wish we had:

- Watercolor crayons
- Watercolor pencils
- Ziploc bags (gallon or sandwich size)
- Scrubby sponges
- Dish towels (an old one is just fine)
