

Supply List – 6th, 7th and 8th Grades

Each Student Should Have the Following Items for Field Studies

- Backpack and water bottle
- A small first aid kit (ziploc bag with some bandages)
- Plant identification book (we highly recommend the one by Pojar)

**Students should come to school on their travel day (Tuesday or Thursday) dressed for the outdoors with a sack lunch and possible rain gear. You can buy a sack lunch in the cafeteria.*
