

3rd Grade Supply List 2013-14

This year we would like to try a supplies purchasing system that saves you time and money, and helps maintain equity for all students.

Thank you so much for equipping your child with these essential supplies. We welcome additional supplies for those in need!

\$25 and the following personal supplies for your child:

Pencil box

Small pack colored pencils

12 pencils (Ticonderoga are THE BEST!)

Scissors

2 white art erasers

Pencil sharpener with shavings catcher

One box of tissues

1 clip board with child's name on it (particleboard w/metal clip preferred – nothing fancy!)

2 reams of paper (please - ***not*** wrapped in plastic!)

One box cracker-style snack

One pack dried fruit

The \$25 buys your child all the folders, binders, composition books, Sharpies, post-its, white board markers, watercolor paper, copy paper, tissues, additional glue sticks, additional pencils and lined paper they will need for the entire year. As you know, school supplies can quickly add up to over \$50, so we hope this will help ease the cost for you and your family.

Alternately, you could buy these supplies separately:

3-ring binder (1½")

5 subject dividers

2 Composition Books (please no spirals or notebooks with removable paper)

1 clip board with child's name on it (particleboard w/metal clip preferred – nothing fancy!)

4 packs of 12 Ticonderoga pencils (other brands do not sharpen or erase well)

1 pack pencil top erasers

1 12-pack **fine** point Sharpies

1 12-pack **ultra-fine** point Sharpies

1 box tissues (remove any "Box Tops for Education" and bring those to school separately)

1 box of cracker-style snack (your child's favorite!)

1 pack dried fruit (your child's favorite!)

- 1 roll transparent tape (not glossy)
- 1 roll masking tape
- 2 reams recycled copy paper (please - ***not*** wrapped in plastic!)
- 1 6-pack Expo black whiteboard markers
- 1 pack oil pastels
- 1 pad water color paper (approx. 9" x 12")

We REALLY could use:

- Help making painted paper at the start of the year: We have the paints, brushes and other tools. Let the 3rd grade team know if you can help with this!
- Black whiteboard markers (children use these all year and we can always use more!)

Other:

Decks of cards

Used children's books (ages 7-9 especially!!) They will continue to be well-loved!
