Please bring the following to be used by the class during the school year:

- Colored pencils – (Prang brand is great, but any brand will do)
- Pencils – Dixon Ticonderoga brand is best for sharpening and sharpener...
- Erasers – White Hi-Polymer or Pink Pearl
- Sharpies (fine) – Black and colored
- Highlighters – any color
- Glue sticks – We go through a lot of these!!
- Colored markers – Thin, any brand; Crayola usually has the best price.
- 3 x 5 cards – one package lined; one blank, white or colored
- 5 composition books with lined paper (wide-ruled)
- Scissors – 7” or larger... just not smaller
- Watercolors – Prang, if possible
- 1 package Post-its – any color
- Two reams of white copy paper – some percentage recycled, if possible
- 3 one-subject spiral notebooks (with wire spiral binding, not the black tape)

Wish List:

- Sculpey – (green, blue, black, brown, white, purple, yellow, red, orange – used monthly for year-long moon study. Fred Meyer has a good price)
- Small metal hand sharpeners for colored pencils (Look in the craft/art section at Fred Meyer. They’re usually not in the back-to-school supplies section)
- Paint brushes (all sizes)
- Bones, animal skulls
- Board games (Checkers, Score Four, etc.)
- Dice
- Oregon Postcards
- Gift cards to **Powells** or **Barnes & Noble** or **Amazon** for books for our classroom libraries
- Colored lined paper for final copies in Writer’s Workshop
- Watercolor paper
- Extra composition books (wide or college-ruled)
- Playground balls, basketballs or soccer balls for classroom use
