

Grade 1-2 Basic Supply List

See your teacher's door for amendments to the list and wish items. *It is not necessary to buy every item on the list. We do want every 1st/2nd grader to have a change of socks and clothes in their locker-* it is not that we think they are going to wet their pants, but they are attracted to puddles and slides, they do fall down, and we are outside everyday. The change of clothes and socks can fit in a bag on the shelf or the bottom of their locker. Raincoats and rain boots can be worn from home, or live in the locker for fast changes.

To share with the class:

- 1 box of crackers or other healthy snack every month
- 2 packages of Dixon Ticonderoga pencils (they last and the erasers work)
- 1 package **black** ultra fine point sharpies or **black** fine point sharpies (no colored sharpies please)
- 1 package glue sticks
- 2 package of baby wipes
- 1 ream of recycled copy paper, 1 ream of colored copy paper
- 1 box of Kleenex
- 2 Pink Pearl erasers
- Colored pencils (Crayola, if possible)
